EVALUATION CRITERIA FOR ARTICLES

CONTENTS EVALUATION

- 1. Does the article reflect current state of the art?
- 2. Is the topic and/or its handling innovative?
- 3. Are the objectives clear?
- 4. Is the research method described adequately?
- 5. Is the choice of method and its application correct?
- 6. Are the interpretations and conclusions plausible?
- 7. Are references selected and used well?
- 8. Has the article or its part(s) been published earlier (to the best of Reviewer's knowledge)?
- 9. Is the subject compatible with the profile of the quarterly? If not, what other journal can be suggested to the author?

FORM EVALUATION

- 1. Is the title clear and adequate to contents?
- 2. Is the structure logical?
- 3. Is the language correct grammatically and stylistically?
- 4. Can the text be shortened? Which parts?
- 5. Are illustrations (drawings, graphs, tables) chosen and used well?
- 6. Are references and notes consistent with required principles?
- 7. Is the summary done correctly? Does it include concerning hypothesis, aim/objective, research method, findings, and conclusions?
